Let's make...



Tie-dyed Butterflies!

Materials Needed

- Newspaper or paper to cover work surface
- Coffee filter
- Food coloring of various colors with droppers
- Pipe cleaner
- Clothes pin
- Glue gun or strong glue
- Magnetic tape or small magnet



How to Make It

- 1. Lay out the coffee filter on your covered work surface.
- 2. Using the dropper from the food coloring, make one to two drops on the coffee filter and watch the color spread!
- 3. Repeat with a variety of colors on different places of the coffee filter until you've completed your tie-dyed design.
- 4. Allow the tie-dyed coffee filter to dry completely.
- 5. Once the coffee filter is dry, put two ends together and scrunch the filter in the middle to form wings.
- 6. Secure the shape by wrapping the pipe cleaner around the middle a few times.
- 7. With the help of an adult, glue one side of the pipe cleaner to the side of the clothespin.
- 8. On the other side of the clothespin, affix a piece of the magnetic tape or glue on your small magnet.
- 9. Find a home for your butterfly on the refrigerator or other metal surface. It can hold your favorite artwork or schoolwork!
